Nomination Guidelines and Requirements

Award Nominations Due March 1, 2010

The YWCA San Gabriel Valley is seeking nominations of women who have achieved extraordinary success in their field of work, study or volunteer service. Honorees are selected by a diverse panel of professionals, and will be the guests of the YWCA SGV at the Women of Achievement Awards Luncheon on Thursday, June 17, 2010 at Cal Poly Pomona's Bronco Student Center.

Women Nominees Eligibility Requirements: *Women must meet ALL requirements*

- Reside, work, or have made significant contributions to the San Gabriel and/or Pomona Valley.
- Be 18 years or older.
- Be considered positive role models in concert with the Mission of the YWCA.
- Have achieved extraordinary success in their field of work, study or volunteer service.
- Be available to attend the WOA luncheon on June 17, 2010, in Pomona and be videotaped in advance for the WOA Awards Presentation.

Not for Consideration:

- ✓ YWCA Women of Achievement committee members, current YWCA staff and Board of Directors, and past YWCA of San Gabriel Valley Women of Achievement honorees.
- ✓ Women of Achievement Award recipients from any other YWCA within the past two years.

Nominating Instructions: *Items submitted in support of nominations are non-returnable*

- Complete the Nomination Form
- Include a minimum of one letter of reference (from a person other than the nominator)
- Limited supplemental material is encouraged (e.g., newspaper and/or magazine articles)
- Please respond to the three statements listed below (limit total response to three typed pages)
 1. Describe nominee's accomplishments that make her outstanding in her field of work, study or volunteer service and that contribute to her success.
 2. Describe the impact of the nominee's contributions to business, organizations, individuals and/or the community.
 3. Describe how the nominee has demonstrated values of the Mission of the YWCA, including the empowerment of women and girls and the elimination of racism.

Nominations MUST be received no later than March 1, 2010
